Hello Jerry,

This email is to confirm our revised schedule for starting, and reporting on, the air injection system located in the asphalt plant area of the former Mission Valley Rock Facility (ACEH case RO#0000207).

Background: In LFR's October 3, 2008 Work Plan, we stated that a summary report would be submitted to the ACEH 30 days after the system has operated for 3 months, and quarterly thereafter. Your ACEH work plan approval letter dated October 24, 2008, requested that the system start-up report be submitted by May 18, 2009, coinciding with the routine quarterly groundwater monitoring reports submitted by Tait Environmental Management.

Current Status: After receiving approval to begin work from Hanson, LFR installed an air injection system during March 2009. The system is operational but start-up is pending receipt of a permit exemption notice from the Bay Area Air Quality Management District (BAAQMD) which we expect to receive by end of next week (by approximately April 3).

Revised Schedule: Per our discussion this morning, LFR will submit a start-up report that will include system and groundwater monitoring data for at least the first three months of operation, on August 17, 2009. This date coincides with the due date for the 2q09 quarterly groundwater monitoring report to be submitted by Tait (per your October 24 letter).

LFR will include relevant data from the QMR report in the system report for discussion purposes. We will plan to submit subsequent system reports on the same date as the routine QMR reports.
