Good afternoon Paresh,

Thank you for responding promptly to Dave Reinsma's request on the status of closure of the Dolan site in Dublin.

I want to share the concerns of the Fitzpatrick family regarding the closure effort. Prior to sale of the site to Dublin Honda in January 2006 (which required a million dollars be left in a remediation escrow), Mike Fitzpatrick knew he had cancer and chose the highest level clean up option, overexcavating the contaminated area so that closure could follow in short order. He did not want his widow Noreen to be drawn into an extended remediation process. Mike died in February 2007.

Since that time we have seen a never ending dribble of more monitoring, more reports, and more requests for more studies eat up a considerable portion of Noreen Fitzpatrick's inheritance – almost equal in cost to the primary remediation work. Somewhere in the process the UST Fund stopped its reimbursements. We are particularly concerned that almost a year and a half after removal of the ORC socks in June of 2008 we now hear the County may still want even more studies.

If there is a real threat to drinking water, we are fully supportive of whatever reasonable actions the County thinks we need to undertake. But if the further studies will not materially improve water safety, please let us get this site closed, and let Noreen liberate her remaining retirement from the remediation escrow.

Hello David,

The closure was reviewed by Donna last week. She had identified some issues, primarily with the representativeness of the final groundwater sampling event following the ORC injection. Donna's concerns were whether sufficient time had lapsed from the time the ORC injection took place to when the groundwater samples were collected, so that representative water samples were collected and not water samples that may have been

influenced by ORC in the groundwater in the immediate vicinity of the wells. In other words, was there sufficient time for contaminant rebound between ORC injection and groundwater sampling.

I am currently researching the case file to address Donna's concerns regarding the site. We should have a response to you by mid-January 2010.
