Subject: Clean fill stockpile samples for Holland Park

Jerry,

We collected six individual samples from the soil stockpiles located at the Sky West Golf Course in Hayward. We analyzed the samples for constituents listed in the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) *Information Advisory, Clean Imported Fill Material* guidelines, including total petroleum hydrocarbons by gasoline (TPHg) and diesel (TPHd) using EPA Method 8015B, PCBs using EPA Method 8082, volatile organic compounds (VOCs) using EPA Method 8260B, semi-volatile organic compounds (SVOCs) using EPA Method 8270C, Title 22 Metals using EPA Method 6010B, and organochlorine pesticides using EPA Method 8081. We did not analyze asbestos because the source area does not appear to be in the vicinity of any naturally occurring asbestos formations.
