Phone call with Larry Lepore of HARD. HARD has arrangements with federal and state agencies that require case closure. He was not aware that contamination had been detected during excavation at County parcel. We discussed the potential that the case could be split into two cases by parcel to allow HARD parcel to move toward closure. My management would need to approve this. Larry will send a written request to split the case into two separate cases by parcel. Will need to execute a deed restriction.
