Dear Mr. Sprague,

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) staff has reviewed the figure showing the repositioned location for boring SB-11 submitted to ACEH by email on February 11, 2014 by ANTEA Group (ANTEA). This location is acceptable by ACEH.

ACEH noted that the soil boring at the location of the MW-19, proposed in the work plan dated November 22, 2013, prepared by ANTEA for the subject site, has been omitted from the figure. As requested in ACEH's Directives dated February 7, 2014 and February 10, 2014, please advance a boring at the MW-19 location for the recovery of a grab-groundwater sample(s) as part of the groundwater investigation.

ACEH will perform a review of ANTEA's Remedial Action Plan, dated April 23, 2013, and their Corrective Action Plan, dated November 22, 2013, prepared for the subject site and will provide comments addressing these documents by the end of this week.

Mr. Nowell:

Attached is the revised site plan with the boring location as we agreed upon.

Also, as I indicated previously, PC&F is moving forward with their site raze and rebuild. Antea Group had previously indicated that we would be performing excavation work at the same time to address the secondary source material beneath the site. This work will likely take place during the second quarter of this year. Also, I would like to know if you are going to require an updated RAP for this work? Antea Group submitted a RAP to your office for your review back in April of last year. The only changes to the proposed work would be the dimensions for proposed excavation (A2). However, the new dimensions were described and shown in the CAP that Antea Group submitted to your office in

November of last year. Please let me know as soon as possible so that we can address any questions or concerns that you may have.
