Thanks for your call today regarding the proposed changes in analyses for the Harrison Street sites. Based on your concurrence, during the third quarter 2010 monitoring event we will begin analyzing for metals and SVOCs in wells nearest the areas of the former waste oil tanks and clarifier: MW-1 at 800 Harrison, MW-2 at 726 Harrison, and MW-3 at 706 Harrison. We will also discontinue analysis for ethanol at 800 Harrison.

## Hello Donna,

We have not heard if there is a new case worker for the sites at 706, 726, and 800 Harrison Street, or if we should continue to contact you regarding these sites. In our third quarter 2009 monitoring and sampling report for these sites, we had recommended groundwater analyses for metals and SVOCs in several wells, and that analysis for ethanol at 800 Harrison be discontinued. We did not receive regulatory concurrence and these recommendations are again included in the first quarter 2010 report, which we are getting ready to submit. In the interest of moving the sites forward, we will implement these recommendations for the third quarter 2010 unless we hear back from you or a new case worker. ConocoPhillips also continues to work with representatives of the adjoining properties to enter into a commingled plume agreement.

I am contacting you because Steven Plunkett informed me that he is no longer the case worker for the sites at 706, 726, and 800 Harrison Street in Oakland. On behalf of ConocoPhillips, we have been working with the other responsible parties to enter into a commingled plume agreement. At this time, the management of the case at 800 Harrison Street is in the process of being transferred from ConocoPhillips to Chevron. We will keep working with Chevron and the other RPs to finalize the commingled plume agreement, and continue to provide coordinated groundwater monitoring reports with Stantec as the lead consultant.
