Mr. Millman,

A data gap was identified and ACEH did approve installation and sampling of the wells in our letter dated September 30, 2013. Since the wells were installed for a defined purpose, it would seem to be most reasonable to sample the newly installed wells once.

However, once the Cleanup Fund recommends case closure, Local Oversight Programs are not to issue additional directives or enforce existing directives until the Board makes a decision on closure of the tank case. In other words, sampling the wells once is the most appropriate action technically but we could not enforce sampling of the wells if you decided not to proceed.

Mr. Wickham,

I received a copy of the 04 December 2013 letter response to the Cleanup Fund by your office for the Oakland Truck Stop site. The letter states that the Cleanup Fund has determined that the case is appropriate for closure. Monitoring wells were just installed, developed, and surveyed at the site in late November 2013 as proposed in the *Monitoring Well Installation Work Plan* dated 17 September 2013 and approved by ACEH by letter dated 30 September 2013. The new wells (deep and shallow), along with existing wells are scheduled to be sampled on 19 December 2013. Should the sampling event be cancelled due to the determination by the Cleanup Fund and the impending closure of the site? OR maybe should just the newly installed wells be sampled once? What are your thoughts?
