
Figure 1 – Site Plan

On behalf of BP West Coast Products, LLC (BP West), ARCADIS-US, Inc. is pleased to submit this Groundwater Monitoring Well Destruction Completion Memorandum to the Alameda County Environmental Health Department (ACEH). This Memorandum documents the destruction of four monitoring wells at the Former British Petroleum (BP) Station #11127 (site) located at 5425 Martin Luther King Jr. Way Oakland, California (Figure 1). Destruction of monitoring wells MW-1 through MW-4 was approved by ACEH in their Correspondence dated September 16, 2010 (Attachment A). Destruction of the wells was required after the approval of case closure at the site.

Prior to conducting the field activities, ARCADIS obtained well destruction permits W2010-0744 through W2010-0747 from Alameda County Public Works Agency (ACPW). Copies of the permits are included as Attachment B. ARCADIS contracted WDC Exploration and Wells (WDC) of Richmond, California to properly destroy the wells. WDC is a California-licensed drilling contractor (C57 License No. 283326). All monitoring wells were destroyed on November 5, 2010.

The wells were backfilled with neat cement grout using a tremie pipe until the displaced groundwater reached the bottom of the well box. Table 1 below provides estimates of the amount of neat cement grout pumped into each monitoring well. The displaced groundwater was removed using a vacuum and stored in a 55-gallon drum. Once the well was backfilled using the tremie pipe, the well was pressure-grouted for

approximately 5 minutes at a pressure of approximately 20 psi. After grouting was completed, the well box was removed by WDC, and the remainder of each borehole was completed with concrete mixed with black dye to match the existing surface.

All project-derived wastes were contained in one (1) Department of Transportation-approved 55-gallon steel drum. The drum was labeled and temporally stored on-site pending proper disposal. The drum were removed from the site on November 10, 2010, by Belshire Environmental Services, Inc. Waste Disposal Documentation is included as Attachment C.

Well Completion Reports were submitted to the Department of Water Resources and copies are included in Attachment D.

With the completion of the above mentioned well abandonment activities, ARCADIS does not believe that there are any remaining issues associated with ACEH Case RO0000241; therefore, this site should be considered closed with regard to the previous environmental issues associated with this site. 

Final approval of case closure for the underground storage tank investigation at the subject site is almost complete. A case summary report proposing closure had been forwarded to the Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB) on September 10, 2010 for their thirty (30) day review period. The RWQCB notified Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) that they have no comments on the proposed closure action. Since no comments opposing closure were received, the monitoring wells installed at the site must be properly destroyed, per California Water Code and all current record owners of fee title to the site must be notified by the primary or active responsible party of the proposed closure action, prior to issuance of a remedial action completion certificate.

ACEH requests that you address the following technical comments, perform the proposed work, and send us the technical reports requested below. Upon receipt of the requested documents a remedial action completion certificate will be sent to the responsible party.

TECHNICAL COMMENTS

- Monitoring Well Destruction ACEH is requesting that you contact Alameda County Public Works Agency at (510) 567-6791, obtain the necessary permits, destroy the wells, and electronically upload the monitoring well destruction report to ACEH's FTP server and the State Water Resources Control Board's GeoTracker website within ninety (90) days from the date of this letter (December 15, 2010). Electronic reporting is described in detail below.
- 2. Landowner Notification Form As you may be aware, an investigation resulting from underground storage tank leaks was performed at the subject property to which you are named as the primary or active responsible party. Pursuant to Section 25297.15 (a), Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH), the local agency, shall not consider cleanup or site closure proposals from the primary or active responsible party, issue a closure letter, or make a determination that no further action is required with respect to a site upon which there was an unauthorized release of hazardous substances from an underground storage tank subject to this chapter unless all current record owners of fee title to the site of the proposed action have been notified of the proposed action by the primary or active responsible party. ACEH is required to notify the primary or active responsible party of their

requirement to certify in writing to the local agency that the notification requirement in the above-mentioned regulation has been satisfied and to provide the local agency with a complete mailing list of all record fee title owners.

To satisfy the above-mentioned requirement, please complete the enclosed "List of Landowners Form," and mail it back to ACEH within thirty (30) days from the date of this letter. Also your comments, if any, must be considered prior to the proposed cleanup or closure. Please respond within 30 days from the date of this letter for your comments to be considered.

Upon our receipt of the completed Landowner Notification Form and report of well destruction, (which includes confirmation of investigation derived waste disposal) this office will issue you the remedial action completion certificate

Please schedule and complete the fieldwork activities by the date specified below and provide ACEH with at least three (3) business days notification prior to conducting the fieldwork.

Specific Work Permit Conditions

- 1. Drilling Permit(s) can be voided/ cancelled only in writing. It is the applicant's responsibility to notify Alameda County Public Works Agency, Water Resources Section in writing for an extension or to cancel the drilling permit application. No drilling permit application(s) shall be extended beyond ninety (90) days from the original start date. Applicants may not cancel a drilling permit application after the completion date of the permit issued has passed.
- 2. Prior to any drilling activities, it shall be the applicant's responsibility to contact and coordinate an Underground Service Alert (USA), obtain encroachment permit(s), excavation permit(s) or any other permits or agreements required for that Federal, State, County or City, and follow all City or County Ordinances. No work shall begin until all the permits and requirements have been approved or obtained. It shall also be the applicants responsibilities to provide to the Cities or to Alameda County an Traffic Safety Plan for any lane closures or detours planned. No work shall begin until all the permits and requirements have been approved or obtained.

- 3. Compliance with the well-sealing specifications shall not exempt the well-sealing contractor from complying with appropriate State reporting-requirements related to well construction or destruction (Sections 13750 through 13755 (Division 7, Chapter 10, Article 3) of the California Water Code). Contractor must complete State DWR Form 188 and mail original to the Alameda County Public Works Agency, Water Resources Section, within 60 days. Including permit number and site map.
- 4. Applicant shall submit the copies of the approved encroachment permit to this office within 60 days.
- 5. Permittee shall assume entire responsibility for all activities and uses under this permit and shall indemnify, defend and save the Alameda County Public Works Agency, its officers, agents, and employees free and harmless from any and all expense, cost and liability in connection with or resulting from the exercise of this Permit including, but not limited to, property damage, personal injury and wrongful death.
- 6. Applicant shall contact assigned inspector listed on the top of the permit at least five (5) working days prior to starting, once the permit has been approved. Confirm the scheduled date(s) at least 24 hours prior to drilling.
- 7. Permittee, permittee's contractors, consultants or agents shall be responsible to assure that all material or waters generated during drilling, boring destruction, and/or other activities associated with this Permit will be safely handled, properly managed, and disposed of according to all applicable federal, state, and local statutes regulating such. In no case shall these materials and/or waters be allowed to enter, or potentially enter, on or off-site storm sewers, dry wells, or waterways or be allowed to move off the property where work is being completed.
- 8. Remove the Christy box or similar structure.

Destroy well by grouting neat cement with a tremie pipe or pressure grouting (25 psi for 5min.) to the bottom of the well and by filling with neat cement to three (3-5) feet below surface grade. Allow the sealing material to spill over the top of the casing to fill any annular space between casing and soil.

After the seal has set, backfill the remaining hole with concrete or compacted material to match existing conditions.

9. Copy of approved drilling permit must be on site at all times. Failure to present or show proof of the approved permit application on site shall result in a fine of \$500.00.
