Transportation of Existing Soil Contaminated by Unleaded Gas from Park District Property in Alameda County to Contra Costa County

Dear Mr. Andrews:

Currently, approximately 600 CY of contaminated soil is stockpiled at a site in Redwood Park in Alameda County. The site for the stockpiled material at Redwood Park is too small and restricted for aeration purposes. The Park District would like to transport the contaminated soil to a less restricted and open level area approximately 200' x 350' in Sibley Regional Preserve in Contra Costa County.

The Park District will cover the stockpiled contaminated soil with plastic sheets for the duration of the rainy season. After the rainy season is over, the Park District will spread out the contaminated soil to approximately 6-inch thick layer for aeration over a long of time. The contaminated soil will be occasionally disked to stimulate aeration and will be monitored by the Park District staff.

At the conclusion of the aeration process, the Park District will retain an Environmental Hazardous Waste Consultant firm to conduct sampling and analysis of the layered contaminated soil. A copy of the report will then be forwarded to your office.

Enclosed is a copy of the map showing the location for the area where the contaminated soil will be aerated.

Please send me your letter of approval for transporting this material into Contra Costa County.
