Thanks for your correspondence regarding this case. Pursuant to our email and telephone conversations of the fall (I don't think these have been recorded to the FTP), I was to collect and transmit the map showing the location of utilities in the vicinity of the UST basin.

I visited the site shortly thereafter (we had spoken about you meeting me for this visit but I don't think we were able to coordinate this) and observed that there were no deeply buried utilities anywhere near the tank, but in my reviewing the file it appears as if I failed to communicate this to you.

I have asked Public Works for a map of utilities (though if recollection serves I don't think one exists, thus me having to go to the site myself).

I recognize that there are many things competing for your limited time. To make this not one of them it might be useful for us to take 15 minutes to discuss exactly what I need to do to help you bring this case to its proper conclusion.
