Dear Mr. Bauhs:

At the request of Chevron Products Company (Chevron), Delta Environmental Consultants, Inc. (Delta) network associate Gettler-Ryan Inc. (GR) is submitting this work plan addendum #2 for the above mentioned site (Figure 1), as requested by Alameda County Health Care Service Agency (ACHCSA) personnel during a phone conversation on December 20, 2001 and in letter dated, December 20, 2001. The proposed changes are in reference to the previously submitted Delta report, *Work Plan Addendum for Monitoring Well Installation and Soil Boring*, dated December 13, 2001.

- In an effort to evaluate the dissolved hydrocarbon plume in the area of the former UST complex, dispenser islands, and near former groundwater monitoring wells C-1 and C-2; GR proposes moving groundwater monitoring well C-8 southwest (downgradient) of former well C-1,
- GR proposes to advance one soil boring to groundwater and collect a grab groundwater sample at a location between former wells C-1 and C-2 as presented in Figure 2, and
- Finally, GR proposes two soil borings to groundwater and collection of grab groundwater samples at locations north of the property boundary (upgradient of former well C-2) and southwest (downgradient) of the former dispenser island located near Grove Way.



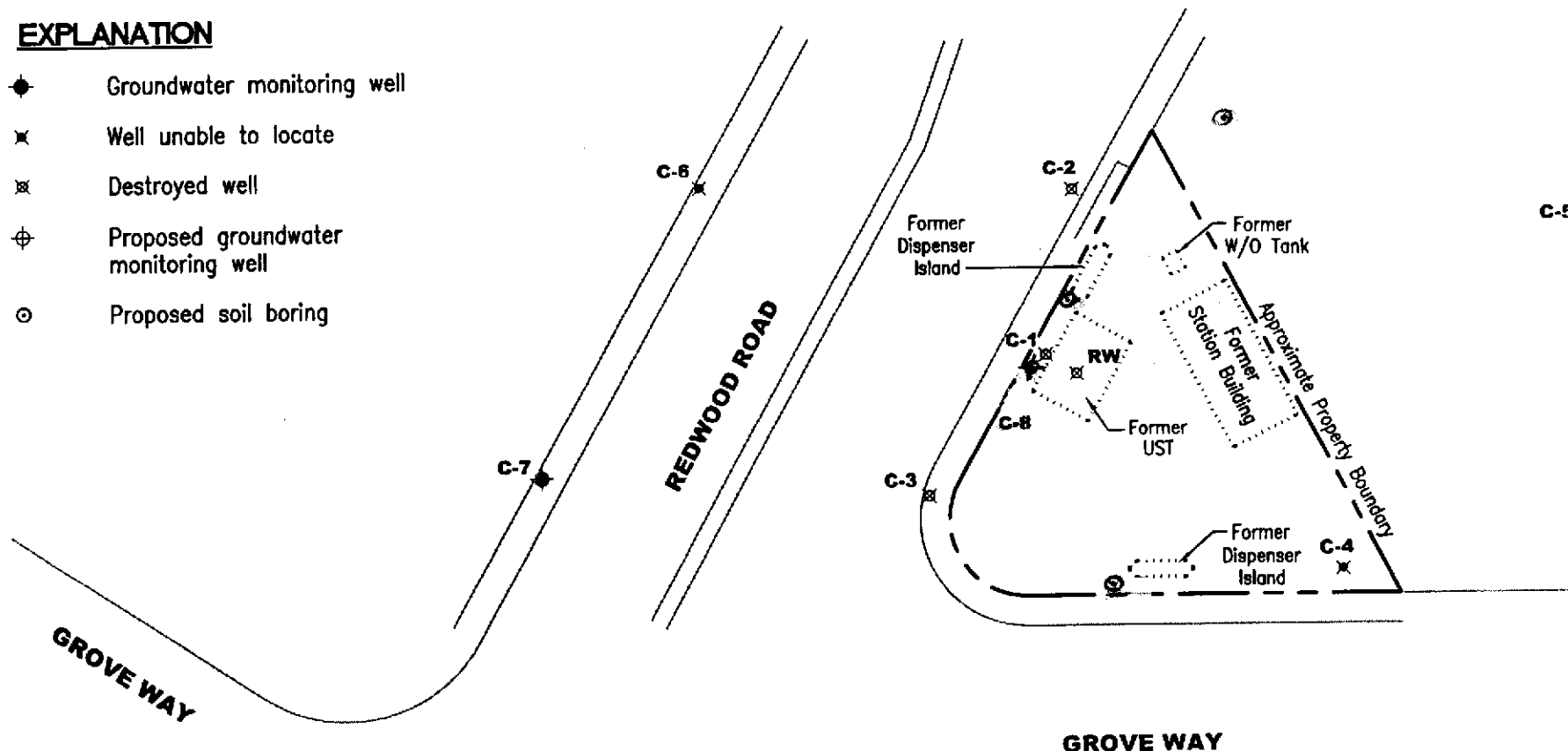

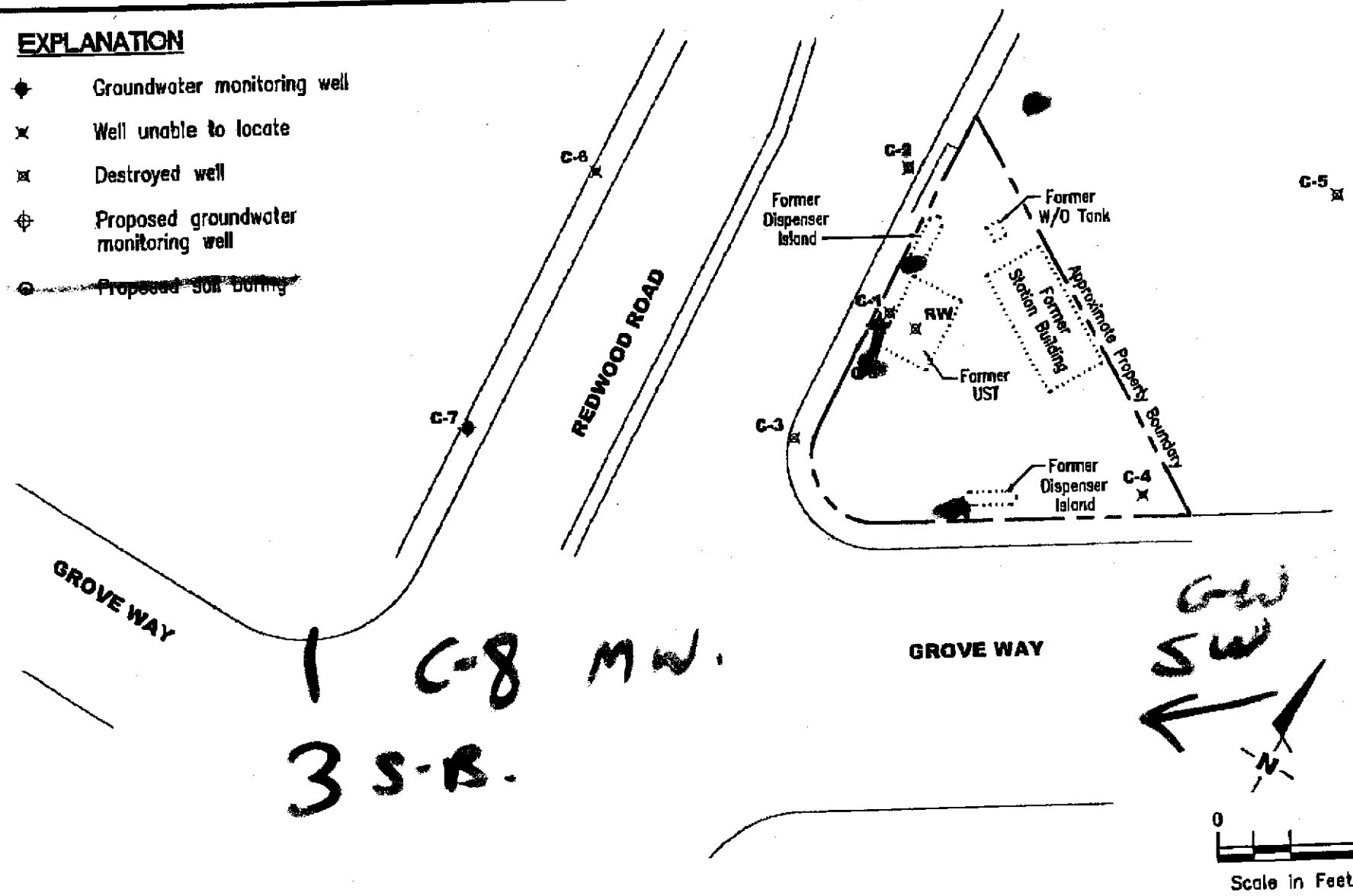
