I work for Paul King at RGA, and per his conversation with you, he asked that I send an email with the titles of the 5 monitoring and sampling reports that we uploaded to Geotracker today. They are as follows:

- First Quarter 1999 Groundwater Sampling Activities at Scooter's Auto Repair dated June 16, 1999 and prepared by HK2, Inc./SEMCO (0645.GWM\_R\_1999-06-16.pdf),
- Second Quarter 1999 Groundwater Sampling Activities and Underground Utility Site Survey Activities - Scooter's Auto Repair dated August 29, 2000 and prepared by North State Environmental(0645.GWM\_R\_2000-08-29.pdf),
- Second Quarter 2000 Groundwater Sampling Activities - Scooter's Auto Repair dated January 23, 2001 and prepared by North State Environmental (0645.GWM\_R\_2001-01-23.pdf),
- Groundwater Monitoring and Sampling Report Third Quarter 2005 dated January 29, 2006 and prepared by Kodiak Consulting, LLC (0645.GWM\_R\_2006-01-29.pdf), and
- Groundwater Monitoring and Sampling Report Fourth Quarter 2005 dated April 13, 2006 and prepared by Kodiak Consulting, LLC (0645.GWM\_R\_2006-04-13.pdf),

Since EDFs were not created prior to 2005, there are no EDFs for the first 3 reports dated in 1999, 2000, and 2001. I contacted Entech to attempt to get EDF files for the last two reports both dated in 2006, and the lab, which is now accutest, said they cannot assist us since they are no longer entech.

Dear Mr. King,

I received an email forwarded from Mr. Steve Carmack regarding file uploads to the State Geotracker website for the subject fuel leak case. I am not aware of the specific files uploaded, but wish to convey that each groundwater monitoring and sampling report typically generates four files for upload to Geotracker. First is the complete report itself, second is the EDF file containing laboratory analytical data, third is the GEO\_WELL containing depth to groundwater, and a GEO\_MAP figure for the site depicting groundwater contours and flow direction, ideally with text boxes summarizing the concentrations of contaminants in groundwater. Every groundwater monitoring well should have a GEO\_BORE lithology log with well construction detail, GEO\_XY and GEO\_Z coordinates.

Similarly, soil and groundwater investigations generates at least four files for upload to Geotracker. First is the complete report itself, second is the EDF file(s) containing laboratory analytical data, third is the GEO\_BORE lithology log for each boring, and GEO\_MAP figure(s) for the site presenting the locations of the borings, ideally with text boxes summarizing the concentrations of contaminants in soil and/or groundwater.

As I do not have an email address for Mr. Carmack, if he is the contact consultant for the subject case, ACEH is requesting you provide his email address so that we can correspond quickly and efficiently regarding your case.

Thank you for your cooperation. ACEH looks forward to working with you and your consultants to advance the case toward closure.
