I did not responded to your several voice mails and emails asking if the vapor mitigation plan had been approved, as I have needed to work the review of the plan into my existing review que at a quicker pace than normal and to do that takes a bit to find the block of time. I am sorry I did not. My goal was to have it reviewed in time for the meeting that was canceled this past Friday, so that implementation could begin in August as originally targeted (see attached). It is my understanding that the meeting was largely for this specific purpose. I have reviewed the plan, and have some questions for Chevron and their consultant. Since last Friday's meeting did not occur, ACDEH will be discussing the plan with Chevron this coming Friday during a discussion for that and four other cases of theirs, with again the goal of implementation in August as previously planned.
