All,
Chevron and their consultant have inquired about the need for next week's working meeting to discuss progress at the Diocese's 3014 Lakeshore property. In that available measures were discussed in the field visit on April 11th, and Retrocoat was identified as a strong candidate, the meeting may not be required. If everyone is in agreement, the next item due is the short term indoor air mitigation plan for 3014 Lakeshore, and a subsequent FS/CAP for 3026 Lakeshore.

Because the mitigation plan does not require a 30 day public comment period a deliverable date of June 15th appears reasonable for some flexibility and to allow for contractor communications. This timeline would still allow implementation by approximately mid-July as originally targeted prior to bifurcation of offsite (3014 Lakeshore) and onsite (3026 Lakeshore) concerns discussed at the site on April 11th, once the mitigation plan is approved or modified by ACDEH.

ACDEH is in general agreement with this approach; however, if there are any differing thoughts, please communicate them to me.
