Dear Community Member:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of an environmental investigation and potential cleanup project that Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) is conducting at the Emeryville Materials Facility at 4525 Hollis Street, Emeryville, CA (referred to as the Site). I encourage you to complete and return the brief community survey enclosed with this letter.

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is the regulatory agency providing oversight of the investigation and any future cleanup activities at the Site. Your response to this survey will help DTSC to determine community interest and conduct appropriate outreach activities to inform the community of the project's status.

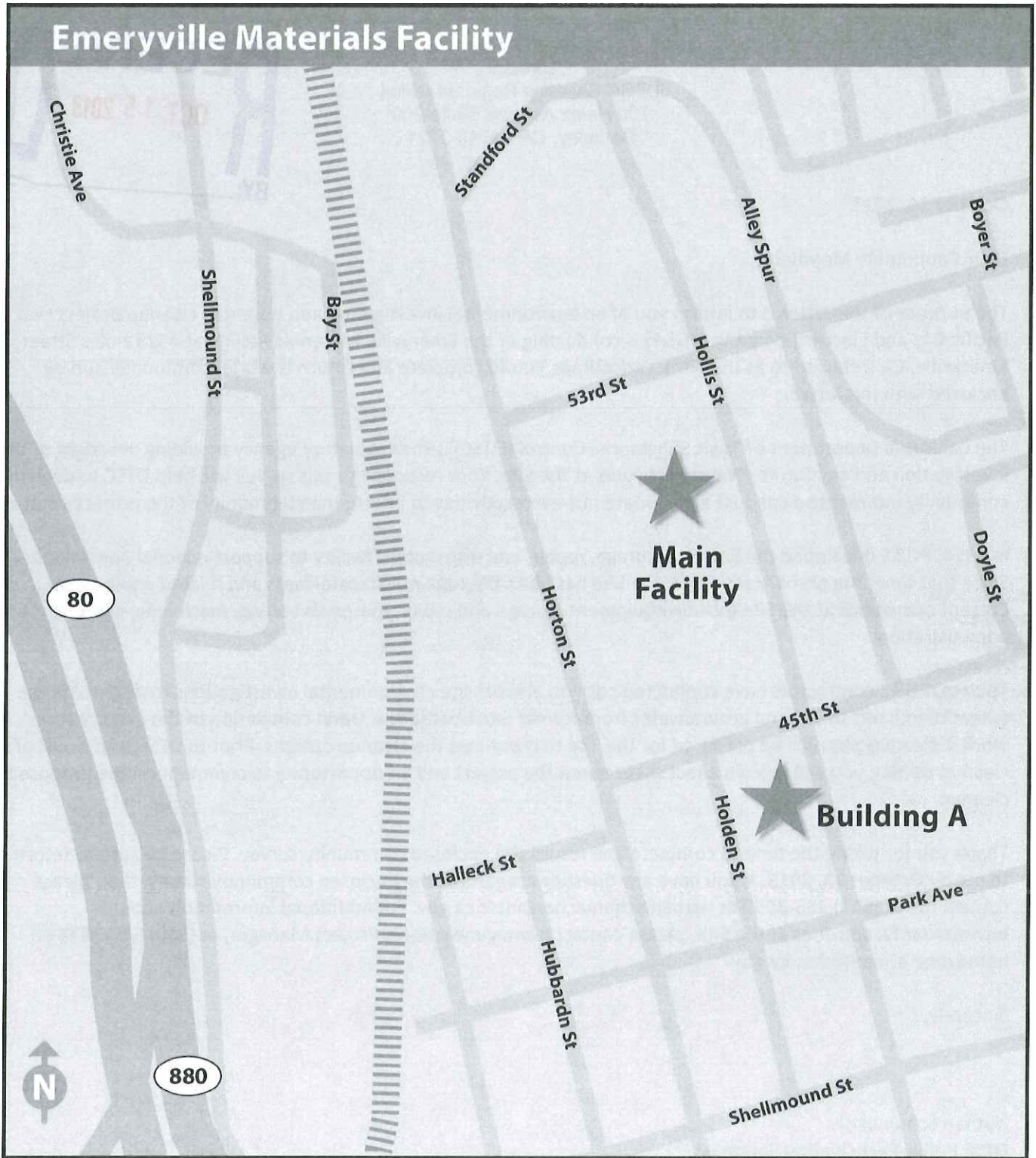
In 1924, PG&E developed the Site as a storage, repair, and distribution facility to support regional operations. Since that time, the primary activity at the Site has been the repair of transformers and related equipment. Current operations at the Site include equipment storage and repair, materials testing, machining, carpentry, and administration.

To date, PG&E contractors have conducted both on and off-site environmental investigations to determine the extent of impacts to soil and groundwater from former Site operations. Upon completion of the investigation work, a cleanup plan will be prepared for the Site that outlines the cleanup options. Prior to DTSC's approval of a cleanup option, you will receive a fact sheet about the project and an opportunity to comment on the proposed cleanup.
