Clearwater has received your letter of August 16, 2010 and concurs with the Work Plan request, however we have a request.

Technical Comment 3. states " At a minimum, resampling of the sub-slab probes is required". Clearwater would like to go ahead and resample the sub-slab vapor points now and incorporate the new data into the Work Plan, rather than waiting on Work Plan approval to resample. Also, due to the discovery of TPH-g vapors near the residential area of the structure, Clearwater would like to install an additional sub-slab vapor sampling point in the residential area of the structure and also sample that vapor point.
