In order to keep forward momentum at the subject site, Stratus requests to submit the results of the soil vapor survey, offsite soil borings, and monitoring well installation under a separate report cover than the proposed sensitive receptor survey as obtaining multi-agency well records is taking longer than anticipated. As such, Stratus is requesting an extension for the submittal of the sensitive receptor survey to year's end.
