Hello Paresh,

Atlantic Richfield Company has finally negotiated a tentative access agreement for us to conduct work at the Former Richfield Oil Company Station #402 located at 1450 Fruitvale Avenue in Oakland (ACEH Case RO307). Your last correspondence of 10/16/2008 regarding this Site requested the RP's to implement a previously submitted "Work Plan for Monitoring Well Installation" (AEI Consultants, 3/7/2005) which had been prepared for the current property owner Fruitvale-Farnum Associates, LLC. Said work plan identified three existing MWs that had been sampled eight times between 10/2000-9/2002, and proposed the installation of up to five more MWs.

During my recent reconnaissance to the Site last week on 1/17/2012, I noted that there were no MW vaults visible in the concrete pavement of the small parking lot. Do your files indicate whether these first three MWs were ever destroyed? I anticipated that a new work plan would have been required anyway, but I would like to know more about the wells that previously existed at the Site. I am going to contact the Alameda County Public Works Agency to ask what their records show also and will keep you appraised of what I find.
