I have reviewed the fuel leak case file for the subject site including the Work Plan for Monitoring Well Installation and Vapor Intrusion Assessment dated October 31, 2012 prepared by Broadbent on behalf of Atlantic Richfield Company. ACEH concurs with the general approach to install new groundwater monitoring wells and soil gas monitoring implants to evaluate residual petroleum hydrocarbon contamination. However, I have several technical comments I would like to discuss with you regarding the proposed scope of work including soil gas and groundwater monitoring well locations, groundwater monitoring well construction, historic groundwater flow directions, and soil sample collection intervals.
