DISCUSSION:

In a letter dated October 16, 2008 ACEH requested the completion of a soil and groundwater investigation as previously approved in the ACEH letter dated June 22, 2006. The approved *Work Plan – Monitoring Well Installation, 1450 Fruitvale Avenue, Oakland, California* (AEI Consultants, March 3, 2005) had been prepared for Fruitvale-Farnam Associates, LLC. Atlantic Richfield Company had repeatedly attempted without success to collectively implement the approved scope of work with the other listed co-Responsible Parties (RPs) listed in the ACEH letters. BP was recently able to negotiate a final property access agreement with Mr. Phua / Fruitvale-Farnum Associates, LLC, on April 11, 2012.

Broadbent has determined that the monitoring wells previously installed at the Former Station #402 site are no longer accessible. It appears that they were paved over or otherwise rendered inaccessible without the appropriate permits or oversight from the Alameda County Public Works Agency (ACPWA). Broadbent has visited the Site and surrounding area to determined locations for replacement groundwater monitoring wells. On June 19, 2012, Broadbent submitted a *Monitoring Well Installation Work Plan*, which was subsequently retracted. An additional revised Work Plan is currently being prepared in response to an email from the ACEH on January 15, 2013.
