Use of Alternative Well Destruction Methods Please be aware that alternative well destruction methods are acceptable to the permitting agency, the Alameda County Public Works Agency, and include pressure grouting. This method is generally less costly than the proposed overdrilling method. ACEH generally encourages cost saving measures.
