Evaluation of Possible Off-Site Petroleum Hydrocarbon Source Areas

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1. INTRODUCTION

SOMA Environmental Engineering, Inc. (SOMA) has prepared this report on behalf of Mr. Mo Mashhoon, former property owner of 5725 Thornhill Drive, Oakland, California (the Site, Figure 1). The Site is bordered on the northwest by residential property, on the northeast by commercial property, on the southeast by Thornhill Drive, and on the southwest by church property. The Site has been a gasoline service station since the 1950s.

This report has been prepared to comply with the Alameda County Health Care Services request dated June 11, 2007.

1.1 Previous Activities

<u>November 1998</u>: Penn Environmental removed a 550-gallon steel underground waste oil tank (WOT) from the Site. Soil samples collected from the WOT excavation contained up to 1,100,000 μ g/kg of total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline (TPH-g), 2,700,000 μ g/kg of total petroleum hydrocarbons as diesel (TPH-d), and 4,200,000 μ g/kg of total petroleum hydrocarbons as motor oil (TPH-d).

<u>February 4, 1999</u>: Penn Environmental over-excavated contaminated soil surrounding the former WOT. Aqua Science Engineers, Inc., (ASE) collected confirmation soil samples from two sidewalls of the excavation. The only compound detected, in one of these two soil samples, was methyl tertiary-butyl ether (MtBE) at 40 µg/kg.

<u>July 1999</u>: ASE drilled borehole BH-A in the vicinity of the former WOT. The only compounds that were detected at concentrations above California Department of Health Services maximum contaminant levels for drinking water were MtBE and cadmium.

September 6, 2000: ASE drilled two more soil borings: BH-B and BH-C.

<u>October 23, 2000</u>: ASE drilled soil boreholes BH-D and BH-E and collected water samples from Temescal Creek. No hydrocarbons were detected in the water samples. Results of laboratory analysis of groundwater samples collected from BH-B, BH-C and BH-D showed elevated levels of TPH-g, TPH-d, TPH-mo and MtBE. For instance, a groundwater sample collected from BH-D contained 16,000 μ g/L of MtBE. The groundwater sample collected from boring BH-C, which is in close proximity to Temescal Creek, contained 5,300 μ g/L of MtBE.

March 1 and 2, 2004: SOMA oversaw drilling of nine temporary well boreholes: HP-1 through HP-7, HP-9, and HP-10. Due to excessive traffic hazards and disruption of local traffic flow posed by advancing HP-8 in the middle of the street, this borehole was not drilled. Groundwater samples were collected

following completion of each temporary well borehole. Locations of "HP" and previously drilled "BH" boreholes are shown in Figure 2. Results of SOMA's investigation did not show elevated levels of MtBE in groundwater samples collected from "HP" sampling locations. For instance, the maximum concentration of MtBE was detected at 1,100 μ g/L in HP-10, which is located midway between BH-B and BH-C. ASE reported higher MtBE concentrations in the "BH" borings, which are located in the area of underground utility conduits and are shallower than the "HP" sampling depths.

Results of SOMA's investigation showed elevated levels of TPH-g, TPH-d, and TPH-mo in soil and groundwater in the vicinity of the former underground storage tanks (USTs). This finding is consistent with ASE's investigations conducted in 1999 and 2000.

During site investigation activities, SOMA oversaw decommissioning of the three existing UST pit wells: MW-1, MW-2, and MW-3.

March 12, 2004: SOMA oversaw installation of three new monitoring wells: SOMA-1, SOMA-2, and SOMA-3 (Figure 2).

<u>April 25, 2005</u>: SOMA conducted a sensitive receptor survey to identify any water bodies or domestic, irrigation or water supply wells within a quarter-mile radius of the Site. Based on State Department of Water Resources and Alameda County Public Works Agency records, no drinking water, domestic or irrigation wells were within a quarter-mile radius of the Site.

<u>May 2005</u>: CPT/MIP boreholes (CPT-1 through CPT-5 and CPT-7 through CPT-11) were advanced under SOMA's supervision. CPT-6 could not be drilled due to physical constraints and obstruction of local traffic. Ten boreholes, GS-1 through GS-5 and GS-7 through GS-11, were advanced at their corresponding CPT borehole locations. Monitoring well SOMA-4 was also installed. Figure 2 shows locations of CPT boreholes and SOMA-4.

Results of the May 2005 site investigation and well installation are presented in SOMA's report, "Additional Soil and Groundwater Investigation and Monitoring Well Installation Report at 5725 Thornhill Drive, Oakland, California," dated June 13, 2005.

1.2 Purpose and Scope of Work

The purpose of this review was to identify any possible sources of dissolvedphase hydrocarbons upgradient from the site. This assessment included the following components, designed to aid in discovery and evaluation of recognized environmental conditions:

• Review of historical aerial photographs and historical topographic maps of properties upgradient in the vicinity of the Site, to identify land use

practices in the area, and to evaluate any potential for impact to the soil and groundwater

- Review of appropriate federal and state lists of contaminated sites to determine whether any property within a 1-mile radius of the Site is under federal or state investigation for soil or groundwater contamination, which could impact or contribute to the environmental impairment of the Site
- Review of historical city directory data to identify historical activities that may have occurred at upgradient sites

This assessment was based primarily on information gathered from other entities, such as regulatory agencies, and government databases. Regulatory agency files and lists may be incomplete, incorrect, or missing. SOMA is not responsible for the accuracy of information provided by others in this report.

1.3 Sanborn Maps

The Certified Sanborn Map Report (Cert #4F90-45AB-BA99) indicated that no fire insurance maps covering the target property were found in a search of complete holdings of the Sunborn Library, LLC collection.

1.4 Topographic and Aerial Maps

To better understand land use practices at the Site and its vicinity, available historical topographic maps provided by Environmental Data Resources Inc. (EDR) Photography Print Service were reviewed (Appendix A). Topographic maps published by the U.S. Geological Survey, which include the subject property and its vicinity, were obtained from EDR Historical Topographic Map Report. No adverse land use practices were noted.

The topographic maps reviewed are summarized below.

- **1915:** Though the City of Oakland street layout is in place, the subject property does not appear to be developed at this time.
- **1948:** Though the subject property does not appear to be developed at this time, small rural structures appear on adjacent streets.
- **1949:** The subject site and adjoining properties generally appear as they did on the map of 1948.
- **1959:** (Series 15) The Site and adjoining properties generally appear as they did in the 1949 topographic map; however, there has been an increase in the number and size of buildings (structures) in the general vicinity.
- **1959: (Series 7.5)** The Site and adjoining properties generally appear as they did in the 1959 topographic map, though Thornhill School is now present upgradient (north) of the Site.

- **1968:** The Site and adjoining properties generally appear as they did in the 1959 topographic map; however, there has been an increase in the number and size of buildings (structures) in the general vicinity.
- **1973:** The Site and adjoining properties generally appear as they did in the 1968 topographic map.
- **1980:** The Site and adjoining properties generally appear as they did in the 1968 topographic map.

To better understand land use practices at the Site and its vicinity, available historical aerial photographs provided by EDR Photography Print Service were reviewed (Appendix A). Seven aerial photographs for areas near the Site were reviewed, dated 1939, 1946, 1959, 1965, 1982, 1993, and 1998.

Photographs reviewed are summarized below.

- **1939:** This photograph shows the general study area as being mostly developed, with the majority of streets and city blocks in their current location. Though the current building layout of the Site was not in place when this aerial photograph was taken, a building structure upgradient of the Site adjacent to the west side of Thornhill Drive is present.
- **1946:** The subject property, as well as adjoining properties, generally appear as they did in the 1939 aerial photograph.
- **1959:** This photograph clearly shows the Site parcel with the current structure (building) and a parking lot in place. The lots north of the Site display the current layout as well.
- **1965:** The Site and adjoining properties generally appear as they did in the 1959 aerial photograph.
- **1982:** Due to this picture's poor quality, as well as the larger scale of the image, definitive conclusions about Site specifics could not be drawn. However, it was concluded that this year's aerial photograph is similar in its content to the previous image.
- **1993:** The Site and adjoining properties generally appear as they did in the 1982 aerial photograph.
- **1998:** The Site and adjoining properties generally appear as they did in the 1993 aerial photograph.

1.5 Environmental Regulatory Agency Inquiries

SOMA reviewed federal and state lists of properties known for soil and/or groundwater contamination within a 1-mile radius of the Site; this information was researched through EDR's automated database search. Results of the automatic

database search are presented in Appendix A. A map produced by EDR (EDR map) shows identified properties in relation to the Site.

The following sites (Figure 1), located upgradient within a 0.25-mile radius of the Site, were identified:

SCHUNEMAN OTTO A GAS STATION

5745 THORNHILL OAKLAND, CA This facility is located at a higher elevation than the Site, hydraulically upgradient, approximately 68 feet northeast of the Site. It is reported to be a historical gasoline and oil service station, and is listed in the EDR Historical Auto Stations database (ID 1009014370)

NUCONOMY CLEANERS

5761 THORNHILL OAKLAND, CA This facility is located at a higher elevation than the Site, hydraulically upgradient approximately 120 feet northeast of the Site. It is reported to be a historical drycleaners facility, and is listed in the EDR Historical Cleaners database (ID 1009139955)

1.6 The EDR-City Directory Abstract

SOMA requested the EDR City Directory Abstract to evaluate historical land use practices. The directory contains information regarding activities that have taken place at the Site and its vicinity since the 1920's. The following summarizes relevant historical land use practices upgradient from the site:

- SCHUNEMAN OTTO A GAS STATION (5745 Thornhill)
- ALMAR CLEANERS (5761 Thornhill)
- NUCONOMY CLEANERS (5761 Thornhill)

1.7 Preferential Pathways

Upon review of available information, it was concluded that depths to the utility lines range between approximately 9 to 10.5 feet bgs near the Site and 14 to 15.5 feet bgs near the Temescal Creek culvert. Figure 2 shows the storm and sewer utility flow lines, their diameters and flow directions. Based on the fact that groundwater is encountered at the Site between 6 and 16 feet bgs, the existing utility trench can potentially act as a preferential flow pathway.

Based on results of SOMA's preliminary evaluation of potential upgradient sources of petroleum hydrocarbons, it was determined that at least one potential historical source, located 68 feet northeast of the Site, is well documented.

Based on our findings, SOMA proposes to proceed with previously planned utility trench sampling to establish background (baseline) concentrations that could be used in assessing plume migration from the Site to off-site locations via preferential pathways. Since some discrepancies between reviewed utility maps exist, the above utility trench sampling will also aid in verifying vertical positioning of the utility trench.

SOMA proposes drilling and sampling one borehole (USB-1), which will be located adjacent to the sewer line immediately upgradient from the Site. As shown in Figure 2, this borehole will be located adjacent to the sewer main on the west side of Thornhill Drive. An "Air Knife" rig will be used to drill and sample the borehole. The drilling crew will advance the borehole by first cutting the asphalt with a concrete cutter to remove a 6-inch by 3-foot slot oriented orthogonal to the marked location of the sewer main. After removing the asphalt and exposing the underlying base material, the field crew will loosen and vacuum the base material through a PVC casing with the "Air Knife" rig. As the trench backfill is removed, the casing will be advanced downward to the bottom of the utility trench. A SOMA geologist will collect a water sample from the trench with a disposable bailer and decant the water sample into VOA vials and one-liter amber bottles. The samples will immediately be labeled and placed into a chilled cooler with ice, pending delivery to the laboratory with chain of custody (COC) documentation.

SOMA field personnel will also collect a soil sample from the trench bottom with a sleeved slide-hammer sampler. The soil-filled sleeve from the sampling shoe, which is covered on both ends of the sample with Teflon tape and capped on both ends with plastic end caps, will be extracted. The sample will be properly labeled and placed into a chilled cooler with ice, pending delivery to the laboratory with COC documentation. Sample(s) will be analyzed, using EPA Method 8260B, for TPH-g, BTEX (benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, total xylenes), and MtBE; for TPH-d and TPH-mo using EPA Method 8015; and for gas oxygenates and lead scavengers.

2. CONCLUSIONS

SOMA has performed a preliminary assessment of possible upgradient sources of petroleum hydrocarbons. Several historical off-site sources of petroleum hydrocarbons or hazardous substances were identified within 68 to 120 feet northeast (hydraulically upgradient) of the Site.

Based on our findings, SOMA proposes to proceed with previously outlined utility trench sampling to verify vertical positioning of the utility trench, and to establish background (baseline) concentrations, which could be used in assessing plume migration from the Site to off-site locations via preferential pathways.












