This e-mail will serve as an update to all the Responsible participants. The current status of the commingled plume application (according to Diane Barclay) is summarize below:

The complete commingled plume fund application is being finalized and sent to all parties for review by next week (8/3/2009). This will involve some legal review, so I can't predict exactly when the application will be submitted; however, things look very promising for the agreement to go forward.

ACEH concurred with the proposal to prepare a SCM for the sites due by September 30, 2009, prior to the completion of a FS/CAP that would address residual contamination beneath all three sites, Currently, coordinated groundwater monitoring was completed for all three sites in August 2009 and a joint GW monitoring report is due by October 15, 2009.

Please be aware that the commingled plume application should be completed prior to the implementation of any remedial action, as the Fund will require pre-approval for all reimbursement costs. At present, ACEH has not received an update on the status of the commingled plume application. Please provide ACEH with a status update on the commingled plume application.
