Hello Brand:

You have my 11/14/2014 Directive Letter below.

You can request accelerated receipt of signed manifests from the disposal site.

Every site is unique, and this case includes traffic control because MW-5 was located in the street, so therefore traffic control is a part of the Well Decommissioning Report. The Well Decommissioning Report needs to include the rationale supporting why actions were taken, so include your rationale for using the analytical for disposal that you just stated: "As for analytical reports, I sent NRC a copy of the most recent groundwater analytical report, as we expect that to represent a conservative characterization of contamination that may be present in the annular well materials."

I look forward to reviewing a complete Well Decommissioning Report.

Karel -

Called but got your voice-mail.

The only directive I'd received is your 11/14/2014 e-mail (forwarded below), which is the same as what is available at the ACEH LOP Documents and GeoTracker web sites. Your 11/14 e-mail didn't include some of the things mentioned in your e-mail today, which requires things that I wouldn't typically include in a well decommissioning report (e.g. traffic control, Oakland permits, analytical report).

The reason I asked about the manifests is because, once the drums have been picked up, it can be weeks before we get the final manifest with signatures from the disposal site. As for analytical reports, I sent NRC a copy of the most recent groundwater analytical report, as we expect that to represent a conservative characterization of contamination that may be present in the annular well materials.

Could you please e-mail me a copy of the directive letter to make sure I get it all included in our report?

As requested in my 11/14/2014 directive letter, a Well Decommissioning Report needs to be submitted to the ACEH ftp site and Geotracker that contains text describing the decommissioning event including a description of traffic control for the City of Oakland and including copies of City of Oakland permits, ACPWA well destruction permits, SIGNED well disposal manifests and transportation documentation, analytical reports, and all documentation supporting that the well decommissioning event has occurred and all drums/containers of soil/groundwater are no longer present at the site. Your statement "*The drums are scheduled to be picked up from the site on April 21, 2015 by licensed waste hauler National Response Corporation of Alameda, California for proper disposal.*" would not be acceptable.
