**RESCISSION OF MINOR ENCROACHMENT PERMIT**

The City of Oakland hereby rescinds the Minor Encroachment Permit and Indenture Agreement recorded on 11/04/1993; series number 93-394157, for the placement of five (5) monitoring wells: MW-1 through MW-5 on Telegraph Avenue, 51<sup>st</sup> Street and 52<sup>nd</sup> Street in Oakland. Said Minor Encroachment Permit and Indenture Agreement were granted to Chevron USA, owner at the time of the property commonly known as 5101 Telegraph Avenue.

This is confirmed in the *Professional Services Industries, Inc.* letter dated July 9, 2015 to *City of Oakland* and delineated in Exhibit A, attached hereto on reverse side.


This rescission shall in no way relieve the permittee from any liability arising from the construction and use of said monitoring wells and the permittee retains sole and full responsibility for any and all claims arising from the installation of said monitoring wells and the restoration of the public right-of-way upon their removal. The permittee shall be responsible for repair of the restoration should the restoration fail or be damaged to the extent of creating a menace or of becoming a hazard to the safety of the general public; and that the permittee shall be liable for the expenses connected therewith.

This document shall be binding upon the permittee, the present owner of the property described in the Minor Encroachment Permit and Indenture Agreement, and their successors in interest thereof.
