All documents we have can be accessed on-line through the link below my name. Choose the LOP Records link in the top center, then select the search tab at the top of the right hand blue column, allow pop ups, then choose LOP document search, and then use the short hand case number (399) in the Record ID - RO Number field. That will get a few sites you can choose from (don't use the map, it's serious slow). There's not much (any that I'm aware of) that are post-2001, the Geotracker upload requirement (the exception being bore/well logs). If however, there are pre-2001 documents ACEH does request/require all documents be uploaded to the ACEH ftp site, as the ACEH website is far more comprehensive. Perjury statements aren't required for pre 2002 (I think, I'm fuzzy on the exact cut off) documents as historical. Hope this helps!
