I received your call yesterday at 3:36 and returned it before 4 pm. Since my voice mail did not take, I thought it best to respond in writing.

Your question was related to why the UST was removed in 1991 and the closure was dated 2012. As stated on my voice mail, the site had been considered to be relatively low in priority (relatively low risk), but ACEH had remaining concerns as to the extent of remaining contamination at the site. ACEH also did not have much success in getting the Responsible Party to undertake an investigation to address those concerns. However, those concerns were eventually addressed in a subsurface investigation in early 2012, and the concerns ACEH had were sufficiently addressed to move the case to closure.

The site was closed to a commercial standard. If the site remains as a commercial parcel, then the only Site Management requirements imposed at closure were the implementation of a health and safety plan to manage exposure to any residual contamination (Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons) and to manage the proper disposal of any contamination encountered that requires special disposal. If the parcel / site is to be converted to residential, it should be reviewed with consideration to the specific proposed development.
