Mark,

Chevron and CRA representatives met with the homeowners on Tuesday August 17<sup>th</sup> to discuss access for future work on their property. During the meeting the owners told us that their house was not constructed slab on grade but built over a crawl space. The presence of the crawl space alters our current strategy to use sub-slab vapor probes and we are currently reevaluating our options. The homeowners gave us permission to access their property for the preferential pathway survey and we are currently working on a date to conduct the survey. Because of these details on behalf of Chevron, CRA would like to request an extension of October 15<sup>th</sup> for the completion of the preferential pathway report.

During the conversation it was also discovered that the house has a sump. This is the first time that we heard about a sump existing on the property. The homeowner stated that one of the previous homeowners installed the sump after the house was originally constructed. The outlet for the sump is in the street curb and discharges into the street gutter. We are in the process of gathering more information in regards to the sump.
