Conestoga-Rovers & Associates (CRA) is submitting this *Door-to Door Well Survey Update* on behalf of Chevron Environmental Management Company (CEMC). Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) requested a door-to-door neighborhood well survey in their June 5, 2014 letter. Therefore, a door-to-door well survey was conducted as outlined in CRA's *Conceptual Site Model Addendum* dated September 25, 2014. One letter received by CRA during this survey indicated that one of the properties may have a well located on their property. Unfortunately the letter returned did not have the property's address on it. As a result, CRA mailed an additional round of letters in November 2014 to identify the property that indicated a well may be present. The most recent mailing was not successful in identifying the property that stated there may be a well present. Through the various letter mailings, CRA has been able to identify several properties that do not have a well, thereby reducing the number of properties from the original mailing list. CRA will send another round of letters to the remaining properties on our list to try to identify the property that indicated that they may have a well present. The results of the next letter mailing will be provided to ACEH by **February 13, 2014**.
