Addendum to GR's Report No. 34638.003, Work Plan For Monitoring Well Installation (dated August 25, 1998), Chevron Station #9-4800, 1700 Castro Street, Oakland, CA.

Mr. Briggs:

This Work Plan Addendum was prepared at the request of Chevron Products Company. The original Work Plan proposed installation of one upgradient well adjacent to 18th Street, and one downgradient well adjacent to Castro Street. At the request of Ms. Eva Chu, Alameda County Health Care Services Agency, Chevron will install one additional downgradient groundwater monitoring well in the southwest corner of the site at the intersection of 17th and Castro Streets. Sample handling and well construction procedures are discussed in the original Work Plan. The proposed location of this well is shown on Figure 2 (attached).

Soil and groundwater samples from the proposed well will be analyzed as described in the original Work Plan. In addition, one saturated and one unsaturated soil sample from the upgradient well boring drilled adjacent to 18th Street will be analyzed for fraction of organic carbon (Whatly-Black Method), porosity, wet and dry bulk density, and moisture content (unsaturated sample).


