Jerry,

As was discussed with you and Shell on or about May 16<sup>th</sup>, you requested that monitoring wells and a soil vapor sampling point be installed outside of the proposed excavation limits and prior to any chemical oxidant placement. Two monitoring wells and a vapor point are proposed as shown on the attached figure, and will be installed on Friday, May 30<sup>th</sup>, under permit from Alameda Co Public Works Dept.

A work plan was not prepared due to time constraints; however, we plan to follow the same procedures/protocol as we used for the recently installed wells that were destroyed due to the excavation work. This work will be documented in a subsequent report of activities.

It is our understanding that the excavation activities will begin (shoring work) the week of June 2<sup>nd</sup>.
