## Art,

No problem with the calls; our training hasn't allowed for much time for me to be at my desk today. I've attached a copy of our December 11, 2013 letter that provided final approval of the Remedial Action Plan and subsequent modifications that included the revised location for northern (northeast) compound (the western compound has remained as originally positioned). The final approved map you sent was essentially the same one we approved (your version has slightly more details as it is from a plan set); the positions of equipment did not change.

As mentioned in my voice mails, the northern location was selected based on neighborhood input during a fairly emotional 30-day public comment period. The original location at the SE corner of the site (east of building) would have required cutting large trees that currently shield the auto repair facility and also any remedial compound from the neighborhood, especially from the bedroom windows of the closest two neighbors. Loss of the trees would have affected the privacy of the backyards and bedrooms, from both a noise and view perspective. The northern location avoids both of these problems as the trees can remain and the compound is further from the homes, and was what was approved by AC Environmental Health. This location was also proposed, and thus is endorsed, by the neighborhood.

Hope this helps, but let me know if you have further questions.
