As we discussed, here are copies of the public participation document, the distribution map, a list of recipients, and alternative citing locations from the comments made. The map and recipient list was derived from the county EGIS system. The public comment period was a 30 day comment period that ran from July 12 to August 15, 2013, but was extended once neighborhood responses were received. A public meeting was held at the site on November 7, 2013 at 7:00 pm, and the locations of the containers that were approved (and submitted to county planning) were accepted by all participants at the meeting.
