Monitoring Wells at 2416 Grove Way, (Formerly Chevron Service Station)


This letter is to confirm our telecon of July 28 and 29, 1998, regarding the above subject in connection to the second phase of the Widening and Reconstruction project on Redwood Road and "A" Street between Castro Valley Boulevard and the Hayward City limit.

All of the existing monitoring wells that are within the construction limits will be removed and/or destroyed. Other existing monitoring wells that are not affected will be left in place. After the completion of the project, a determination will be made by your office, whether replacement of one or more of the wells is necessary.

Upon our field verification, monitoring wells MW-7, MW-8, C-1, C-2, and C-3, as shown on the attached drawing, will be removed and/or destroyed in accordance with the guidelines from your department and with the Alameda County Water and Conservation District - Zone 7 requirements. Monitoring wells MW-1 and MW-3 will be left in place.

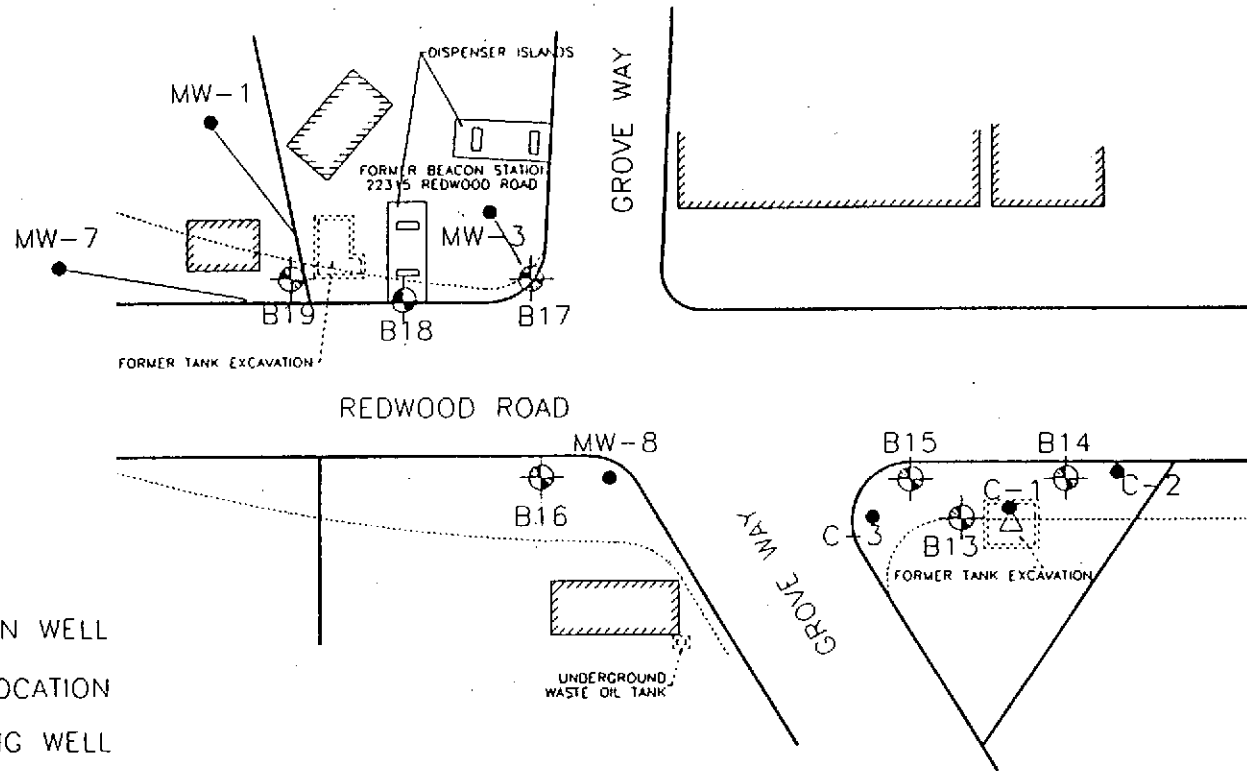

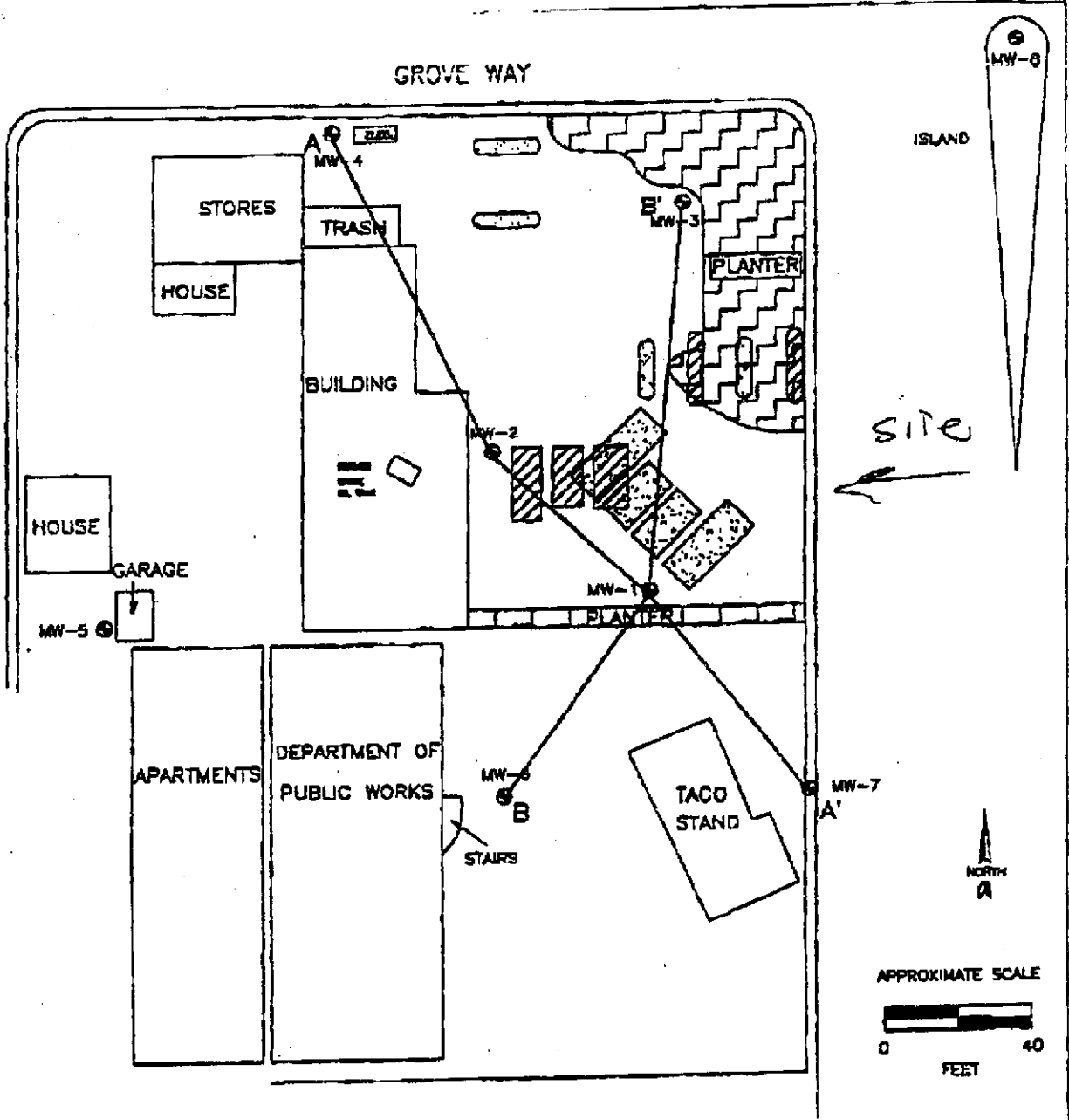

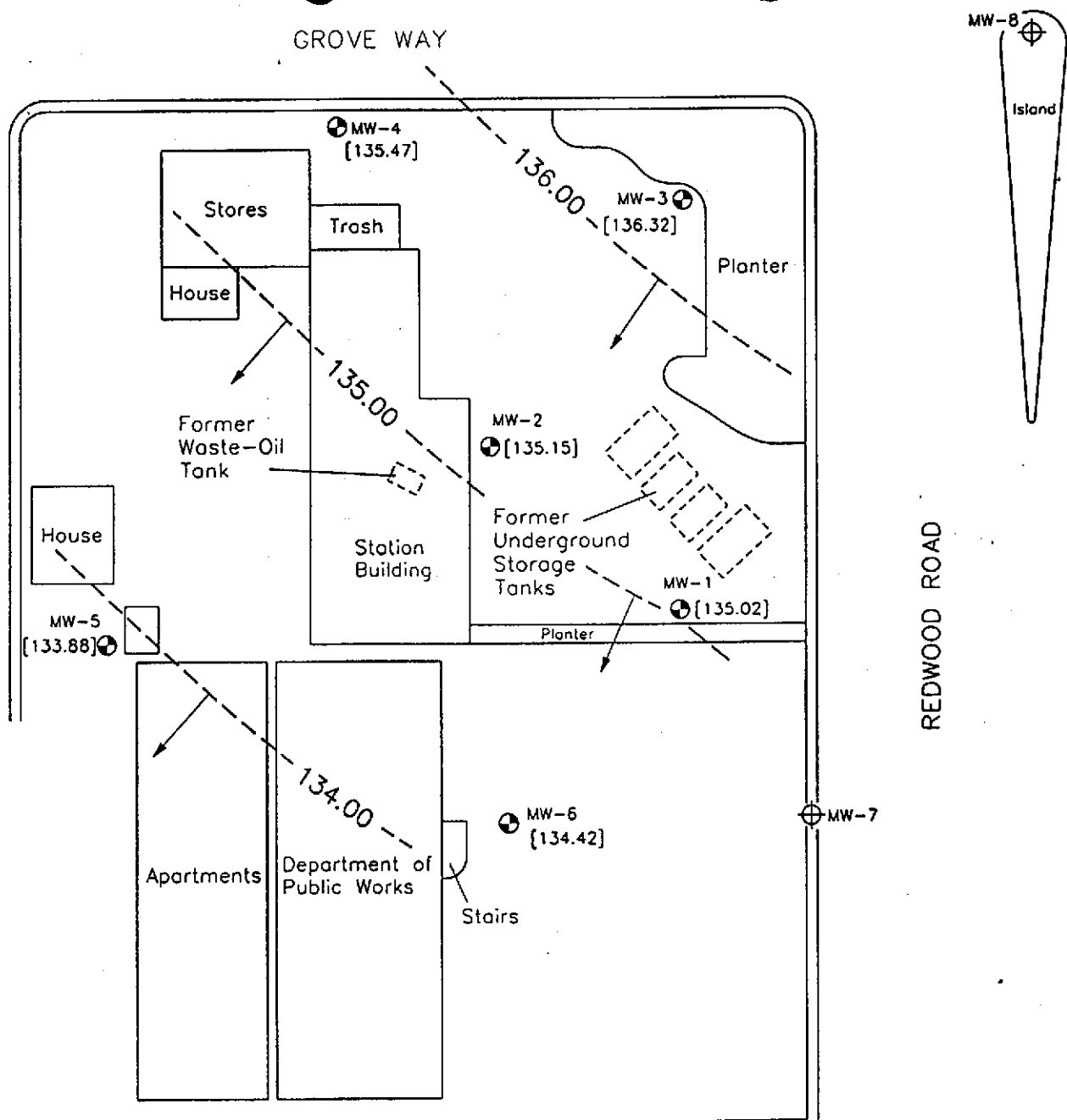

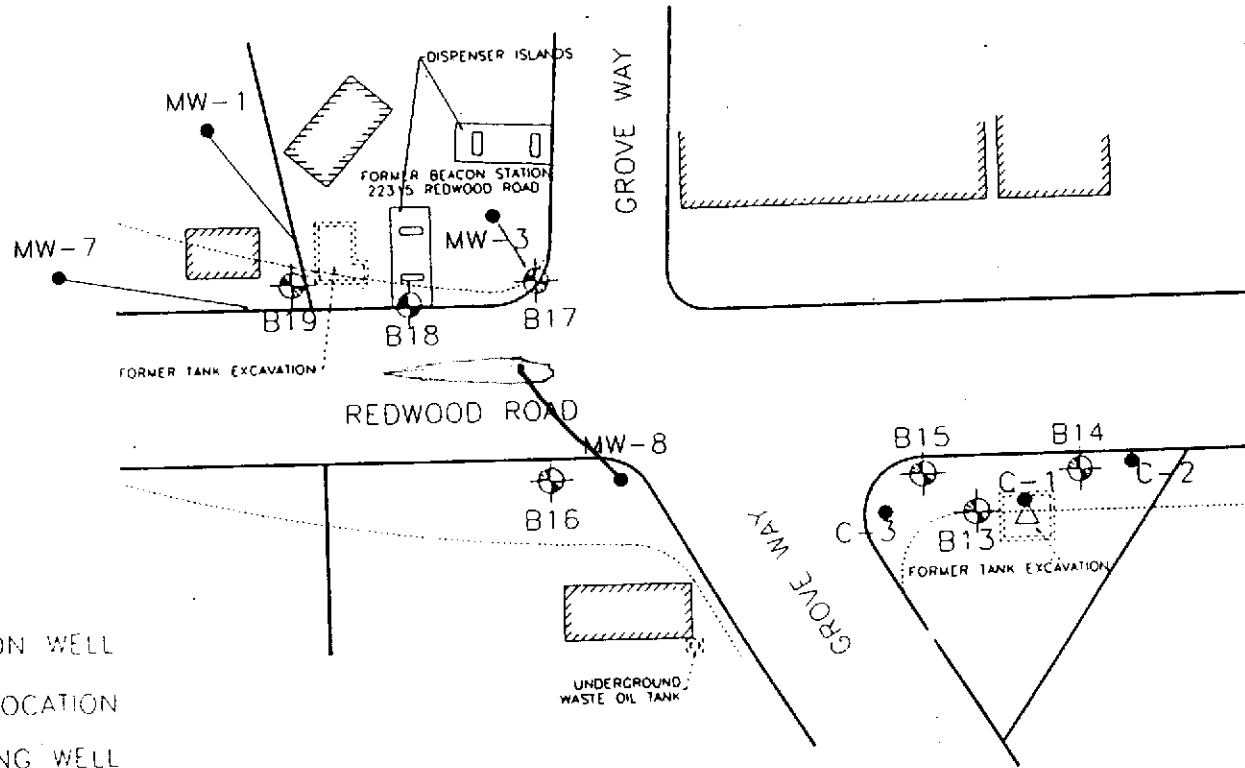
