Dear Responsible Parties:

Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) has reviewed the subject case file and the recently submitted documents entitled *Results of Additional Soil and Soil Gas Investigation* (SWI), dated August 2, 2017 and prepared by Geosyntec Consultants (Geosyntec) and *Closure Request* (RFC) prepared by Antea Group (Antea) and dated October 5, 2017.

The SWI documents the activities and presents findings of a soil and soil vapor investigation consisting of the recovery and analysis of samples from 25 on-site locations. Each of the 25 bores was advanced to a depth of five feet below

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existing grade (BEG). A soil sample was collected from the base of each bore prior to the recovery of a soil vapor sample. Soil concentrations of benzene, ethyl benzene and naphthalene were reported below the threshold levels presented in Table 1 of the State Water Resources Control Board's (SWRCBs) Low Threat Underground Storage Tank Case Closure Policy (LTCP) Direct Contact and Outdoor Air Exposure (DCOAE) for commercial/ industrial sites and for utility workers. No soil vapor concentrations of benzene, ethyl benzene and naphthalene were reported to exceed the LTCP media specific Vapor Intrusion to Indoor Air (VIIA) concentrations listed in Scenario 4.

As presented in the RFC, Antea provides a site description as a vacant lot following the 2014 removal of a gasoline fueling station and summarizes the investigative and remedial actions which occurred at the site. Additionally, Antea provides a review and comments on the LTCP Checklist located on the SWRCBs GeoTracker website. Based on the documentation contained in the RFC, Antea requests ACDEH review the documentation and reevaluate site conditions for compliance with the LTCP.

Prior to updating the LTCP Checklist, ACDEH requests a meeting to discuss the case status and Antea's request for closure consideration. ACDEH proposes a meeting date and time of **January 25, 2018** at 10:00 AM.
