There is no survey data in GeoTracker for this site; it appears the wells were surveyed in 1995. The wellhead for well MW-1 has been modified and not resurveyed, and therefore the well cannot be used in constructing potentiometric maps. The groundwater elevations at well MW-3 appear low relative to adjacent wells at the site. For these reasons, I was going to recommend in the quarterly report that the well locations and elevations be re-surveyed.

I'm going to have a surveyor in San Leandro soon to survey some new wells there, and would like to have them survey this site in the same visit, saving a bit of money. Would you concur with the recommendation to survey the wells? (I'm asking because I want to keep everything on the up and up with the USTCF)
