I called Dave Allen (ASE) to inquire. Mr. Allen did not concur with Mr. Jaber's report that ASE had been given the project. Mr. Allen did say, though, that he had provided a bid for the job last week. He also indicated an application for pre-approval was sent ^{to} and ~~was~~ received by the SWRCB.
