
As you discussed in your February 6, 1996 conversation with Joseph Theisen, this addendum revises certain aspects of Cambria's upcoming site assessment at the site referenced above. Cambria will drill seven soil borings to about 12 ft depth and one soil boring to 25 ft, converting the 25 ft soil boring to a ground water monitoring well. This configuration eliminates one ground water monitoring well (MW-5), replacing it with a boring (SB-G), and relocates MW-4 and SB-A further west. The new configuration is shown in Figure 1.

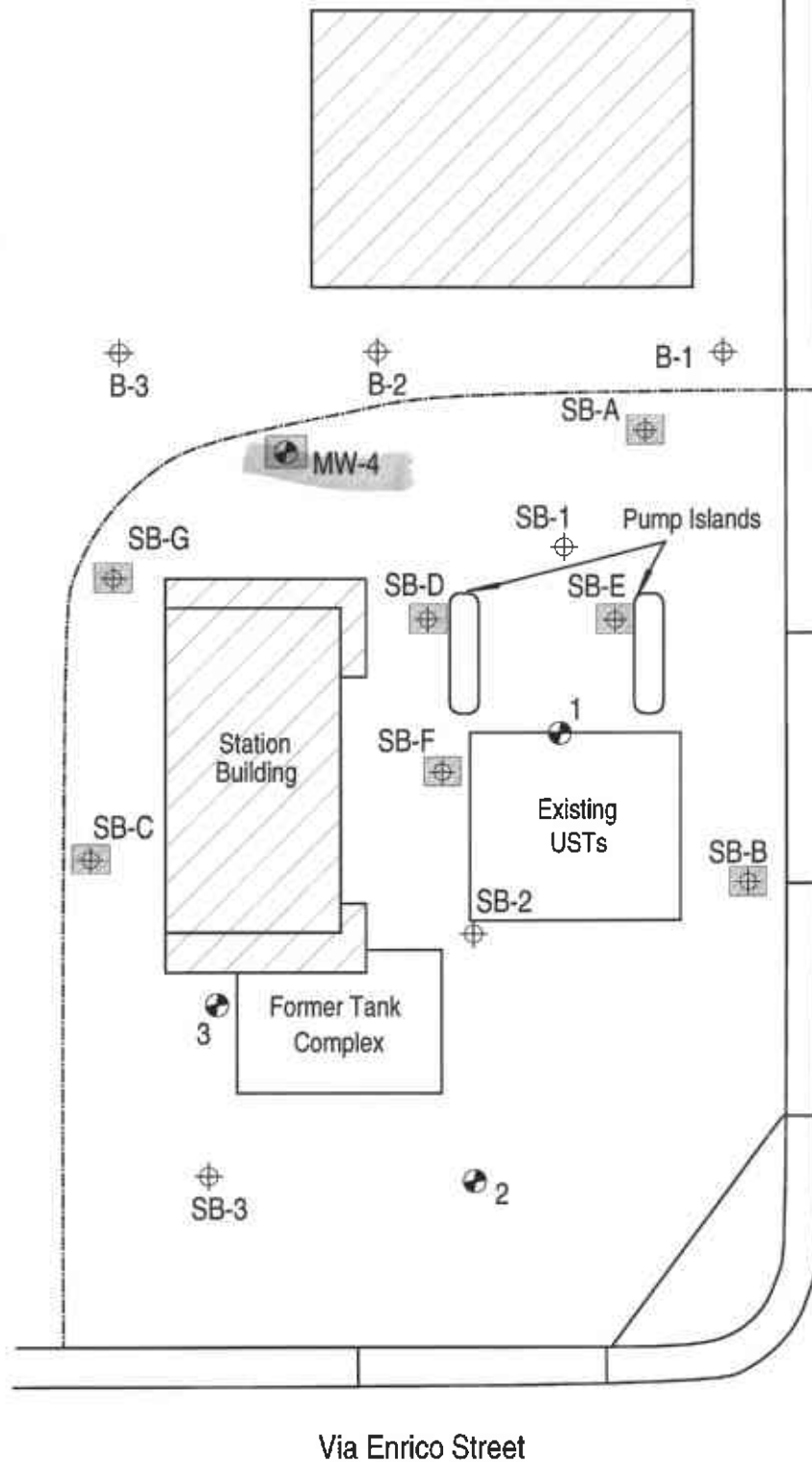
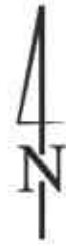

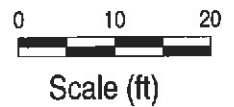
