

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) names a "Responsible Party," as defined under 23 C.C.R Sec. 2720. Section 2720 defines a responsible party 4 ways. An RP can be:

- 1. "Any person who owns or operates an underground storage tank used for the storage of any hazardous substance."
- 2. "In the case of any underground storage tank no longer in use, any person who owned or operated the underground storage tank immediately before the discontinuation of its use."
- 3. "Any owner of property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from an underground storage tank has occurred."
- 4. "Any person who had or has control over an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance."

Responsible Party Identification

Existence of Unauthorized Release

International Harvester operated an approximate 143,000 square foot warehouse as a branch house and equipment service station since circa 1940's. In June 1991 two underground storage tanks (USTs) occupying separate tank pits, a 350-gallon gasoline UST and a 200-gallon waste oil tank, and associated external product piping were removed from the site. Both USTs had either product, oil, or sludge remaining in the tanks prior to removal and numerous holes, up to 3-inches in diameter, were observed in both USTs. Soil samples were collected from both UST excavations with maximum concentrations detected of 240 milligrams per kilogram (mg/kg) total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH) as gasoline, 1,800 mg/kg TPH as diesel, 2,000 mg/kg TPH as motor oil, 1.1 mg/kg benzene, 1.8 mg/kg ethylbenzene, and 0.87 mg/kg naphthalene. These concentrations indicate an unauthorized release has occurred from the underground storage tank system at this site.

Robbins & Marin Financial Corporation c/o Wareham Property Group are responsible parties because they owned the property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from an underground storage tank has occurred (Definition 3).

International Harvester, doing business as Navistar International Corporation, acquired the property on or prior to March 1969. Navistar International Corporation is a responsible party because they owned or operated an underground storage tank used for the storage of any hazardous substance (Definition 1) and they owned the property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from an underground storage tank has occurred (Definition 3).
