## Hello Carryl:

Thank you for the update and the documentation, which should be included in the SCM.

Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons as diesel (TPHd) concentrations were detected up to 10,000 ug/L in MW-1 on December 31, 1996 according to the Summary of Analytical Groundwater Results for the five monitoring wells. To establish a baseline due to the long pause in groundwater monitoring and sampling, please analyze all groundwater samples from this initial sampling event additionally for TPHd, then if TPHd is not detected, it can be discontinued as an analyte.

Hi Karel,

We have been unable to schedule the monitoring and sampling for this site to occur in 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter due to the need for an encroachment permit. We have made the request for the permit but unfortunately it may take up to 6 weeks. In the meantime, we will be coordinating to conduct a utility locate when we will be onsite to conduct the monitoring and sampling, and re-survey the wells. The utility locate will be to locate missing wells as well as sweep the property to understand current utilities and if there are indeed fuel lines still on site. All this information will be used when we develop a work plan.

In addition, we will be requesting well search from ACPW and will be submitting our DWR request in order to complete the Sensitive Receptor Survey. I have also located the attached file that shows we only dispensed Gasoline onsite, consequently upon sampling of the wells, we plan to not analyze for TPHd.

We would like to defer preparation and submittal of the CSM and work plan till we have accomplished the above tasks and have reported the first sampling event in 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter.
