Both Silvera's are very elderly. The Silvera company / corporation is trying to figure out where the site is headed and when it will end, as it seems to be continuing to require lots of money, and they have no real understanding of the site. Requests a possible meeting along with Marsha at Silvera's as they've had no direct contact with us as an agency.

In my return call, a primary concern were funds. I explained the function of the UST CF, that with a pool of money an RP could conduct work, seek reimbursement, receive most / majority of funds back, and then conduct additional work; basically a cycling of the same funds. Mention that up to \$1M could be available, but for this site may not be needed, but also mention that the fund is currently limiting yearly expenditures to approx. \$50,000 due to the general conduction of the state's finances. I explain that "we" (ACEH and consultant) are attempting to focus resources on remedial cleanup, which is also in agreement with the state's 5-year review of site. Briefly discuss proposed pilot test (dewatering and vapor extraction), but are also trying to put a limit on the lateral extent of contamination as that has not been done; basically that utility conduits and a deep well directly downgradient (@ 235 ft) are of potential concern. Also discuss vapor intrusion, something not considered 10 years ago, but now of potential concern. He will call the Paul King to further discuss several change orders due to the recent work requests, and then will discuss with Marsha. Thanks for the time and explanations; it was useful.
