Hi James,

Jerry Wickham at Alameda County Environmental Health has requested that we destroy three groundwater monitoring wells at 744 East 12th Street in Oakland (County case number RO 388). The wells were installed June 2, 1999. However, when we went to inspect the wells prior to permitting on 8/18/08, we only found patched concrete and patched asphalt at the locations where the wells are shown to be located on a map. I have attached pictures of the patched surface at the well locations (documents MW1-3.jpg, MW2-2.jpg, and MW3-2.jpg). We rented a metal detector and scanned the patched locations for buried well covers, but did not get any readings that indicated a buried well cover was present under any of the patches.

Can you please check to see if a permit was issued for destruction of the wells, and if so, who the permit was issued to and when? The property owner is J.W. Silviera of J.W. Silviera Realty, 499 Embarcadero, Oakland, CA 94606. Please let me know your timing of when you can look to see if a permit was issued for well destruction at this site. Thank you!
