Hi Mark,

For site RO391 (Former Texaco 21-1173), we received your letter dated 7/24/09 pertaining to SWRCB Resolution 2009-0042 and the reduction to semi-annual. For this site, we performed the first event in June 2009 (first since 2000) and as I stated previously we would like to include two rounds of data in the SCM. Therefore, we have the next event scheduled for the end of this month (Sept.) on a continued quarterly frequency. Following this event, however, the frequency will be reduced to semi-annual (if continued monitoring is required). Is there any other information needed besides this e-mail?
