Dear Ms. Frerichs, Mr. Brown, Ms. Sedlachek, and Mr. Howard:

As you are aware, an investigation resulting from underground storage tank leaks was performed at the subject property to which you are named as the primary or active responsible party. Pursuant to Section 25297.15 (a), Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH), the local agency, shall not consider cleanup or site closure proposals from the primary or active responsible party, issue a closure letter, or make a determination that no further action is required with respect to a site upon which there was an unauthorized release of hazardous substances from an underground storage tank subject to this chapter unless all current record owners of fee title to the site of the proposed action have been notified of the proposed action by the primary or active responsible party. ACEH is required to notify the primary or active responsible party of their requirement to certify in writing to the local agency that the notification requirement in the above-mentioned regulation has been satisfied and to provide the local agency with a complete mailing list of all record fee title owners.

To satisfy the above-mentioned requirement, please complete the enclosed "List of Landowners Form," and mail it back to ACEH within thirty (30) days from the date of this letter. Also your comments, if any, must be considered prior to the proposed cleanup or closure. Please respond within 30 days from the date of this letter for your comments to be considered.

Additionally, pursuant to California Code of Regulations, Title 23, Division 3, Chapter 16, §2728, ACEH requires notification to the public of the proposed case closure for the site. To that end, ACEH has prepared and will send out the public participation fact sheet (enclosed), which describes the site and previous investigation activities that were conducted to the property addresses listed on the enclosed List of Public Participants. Public comments on the proposed action will be accepted for a period of thirty days beginning Friday March 11, 2011 through Monday April 11 2011.



Summary – This fact sheet has been prepared to inform community members and other interested parties of potential case closure for a fuel leak case at 500 Grand Ave. in Oakland, California. Site investigation and cleanup activities have been completed by Chevron and it does not appear that

the fuel release presents a risk to human health based upon the current commercial land use. One waste-oil and three gasoline USTs were removed in 1990 and 1992, respectively. Subsequent investigations and groundwater monitoring indicates that soil and groundwater concentrations have been reduced to the extent feasible and are limited by structural and public safety concerns. Future construction activities or changes in land use will require a re-evaluation of site data.

Background - The site is currently an untended parking lot located in a commercial district. One waste-oil and three gasoline tanks have been removed from the site, and a series of site investigations have been performed. Remedial actions including extensive removal of soil beneath the majority of the site has been undertaken. Twelve groundwater monitoring wells were installed and the extent of groundwater contamination was defined. Additionally, sixteen soil bores and eight soil vapor probes were installed to help characterize contamination at the site. Groundwater monitoring indicates that the concentrations of petroleum hydrocarbons in groundwater beneath the site and downgradient vicinity (towards the south-southeast) do not currently pose a risk to the public at the site or at surrounding properties. Residual soil contamination remains in place beneath the Grand Avenue sidewalk, extending beneath Grand Avenue, and also remains adjacent to the retaining wall on the east side of the site. Contaminated soil extends to at least the middle of Grand Avenue; however, does not appear to extend to the far (south) side of Grand Avenue. Elevated soil vapor concentrations in the vicinity of the residual soil contamination are present; however, based on the data collected the soil vapor does not appear to present a human health risk under current land use. Residual concentrations will continue to represent a potential concern should the property be redeveloped or the land use change. Concentrations of petroleum

hydrocarbons in groundwater downgradient of the site appear to be decreasing and further restoration of groundwater quality is expected to take place by natural attenuation processes.

Next Step - The public is invited to review and comment on the potential closure of the fuel leak case.
