Dear Ms. Chan,

On behalf of Tony and Rita Sullins, GTI has requested a schedule extension for the implementation of the approved Corrective Action Plan (CAP) for the site from Alameda County Health Care Services. A twelve month extension has been requested and is under review.

The delay is based on financial hardships posed by the Underground Storage Tank Cleanup Fund's current situation. Until recently the project was moving forward to implement the CAP, and the BAAQMD Authority to Construct (ATC) application was submitted prior to this development. In light of this significant delay, we respectfully request that the ATC be temporarily suspended, or that the expiration date be extended for 12-months.

We would be open to other alternatives that may be available to avoid the need for a second ATC permit and fee payment, should the installation and start up of the system be delayed such that the current permit expires before the system is installed and has an opportunity to address the subsurface hydrocarbon contamination.

Should the project be able to proceed, GTI will notify BAAQMD once an installation date becomes firm and will submit Start-Up Notification as appropriate.
