

Rita Sullins called on 8/23/2005 regarding the letter. Abdul from Cleanup Fund told her and her consultant that the site was closable. He told her that the Cleanup Fund would not pay for further ??? Someone also told her that the Cleanup Fund could override Alameda County decision. She asked me about when MTBE was used. She asked why Exxon Mobil was listed. I explained RP process and indicated that letter is addressed to all RPs as required by our regulatations. She wants Exxon Mobil to deal with the problem now. Told her that we do not assign a proportion but the RPs must work that out amongst themselves. They have spent \$300k on the site with no cleanup so far; concerned with reaching the \$1.5M max. She wanted to know what the cost would be but I would not give an estimate. She asked if site was closable and I told her that I did not think it was. 9/30/2005 Chris Davidson from City of Livermore called. The City of Livermore is considering a Pelanco request for the site. She questioned why additional work is needed and was particularly interested in the shallow soil and soil gas measurements.

10?17/2005 Meeting with Tony and Rita Sullins, City of Livermore, Fugro, and Aquifer Science. See meeting notes.

2/2/2006 Rita Sullins called at 12:45 pm. Fugro costs were \$16,500 for soil gas survey. UST Cleanup Fund approved \$10,400. Aquifer Sciences has drawn up a work plan but she can't pay the bill without pre-authorization from Cleanup Fund. Total cost will be \$66k. She will have to pay 15% of \$66k. Abdul say he will pre-approve tomorrow. OK for Abdul to call me with questions. The City paid Fugro then City got paid back by Rita Sullins with money from UST Cleanup Fund. City checked to make sure this was ok. OK as long as there is agreement with City. Rita Sullins has not signed the agreement but she will pay money back.

2/3/2006 Kharim from UST Cleanup Fund called at 10:20 am. Asked what work we were requesting. I looked at my comment letter and indicated four borings with grab groudnwater samples and sampling the existing monitoring wells.

3/14/2006. Spoke with Joe Angulo 209-522-4119 at 10:00 am. Geological Techniques in Modesto. Asked by Rita Sullins to prepare a summary report with recommendations. He wants to submit a report to complete site investigation and

propose interim remediation. Asked if I had any objections to what he was proposing. I had him that case had been convoluted and I would be cautious about changes in direction for site.

3/28/2006. Jenny of Geotechniques 209-522-4119 called re sending reports. Correspondence can be uploaded electronically but there is not a requirement to send correspondence electronically. Wells have not been surveyed at site? Will be sending in report after getting password for our ftp site. May be issue with uploading early reports to Geotrcker; they will upload work from here on out.

4/12/2006. Called Joe Angulo at Geological Technics 209-522-4119. The request for a 45-day extension is just to get a Work Plan. They want to review well permits for site. Question as to whether Sullins are the RP for site. Would want to review our files also. Would not begin work until June.

4/12/2006. 3:25 pm. Left message for Rita Sullins to call.

4/12/2006. Spoke with Rita Sullins. Changed consultants due to cost of proposed work. She came across Geological Technics, Inc. in phone book and is happy with relationship. Geological Technics will do all the Cleanup Fund paperwork for here and knows what costs fund will reimburse. Rita was told by Chris Davidson that she did not have to worry about Pelanco letter from Livermore. Chris Davidson said the letter was just to get Exxon off their duff. Rita is not sure that City has her best interest in mind. They originally wanted Signature Homes to find them a new piece of property so that Signature could get their property. Signature had list of needs and showed them site. Never came to pass. Market has slowed. Signature did some borings on property directly south and west of site.

4/19/2006. Christa Marting called to ask about latest developments on case and whether additional work has taken place.

4/21/2006. Returned 4/20/2006 call from Chris Davidson on 4/21/2006 tel 925-960-4143. Concerned about coordination. Sent Pelanco request on 3/1/2006; I confirmed that we have a copy. Things not happening fast enough. Sullins and Exxon Mobil need to meet their deadline for a remedial action plan. Told her I did not know what they were asking since Work Plans were previously sumbitted for the soil vapor survey and soil borings by Aquifer Science. Livermore claims that City's requirements legally supercede ours. I thought that sending out the Pelanco request on March 1 was bizarre since work was already planned. They want environmental agreements and schedule for cleanup. Exxon Mobil has contacted the City and will be sending them "some information." Chris Davidson stated that Exxon Mobil needs to be active. Rita and Tony Sullins have been slow to act and have delayed project. She will work with the Sullins to have them meet City's schedule for submittal of a remedial plan. I am not available for a conference call on Monday.

5/2/2006. Christa Marting of ETIC called. New project manager for Exxon Mobil Gene Ortega wants to meet. Concerned that Exxon is a named Responsible Party. Exxon's lawyer has talked with City of Livermore re Pelanco. I told that we typically do not get in the middle of assigning proportions for RPs. If you meet one of the four definitions for an RP in Title 23 then you remain an RP. Does not require discretion on my part. Meeting with ExxonMobil will not change RP designation. She will conduct a file reivew to get the latest documents; Exxon is not receiving documents from Geological Technics or Fugro. I indicated I was surprised that there had not been communications with the Sullins.

6/9/2006. Called Christa Marting of ETIC. Exxon is not preparing a Work Plan to submit to City of Livermore. Waiting to see Work Plan and our comments.

7/14/2006. Called Joe Angulo of Geological Technics, Inc. 209-522-4119. Indicated that we need a perjury statement from the Sullins for the Feasibilty Study Work Plan. He will have his office manager take care of getting statement from the Sullins. I will send him an email requesting rationale for location of well EW-1 in the FS Work Plan. I verbally indicated that the revised well locations address our technical comments.
