I'm just trying to suggest options to cover all potential contingencies with one mobilization. The figure appeared to indicate additional room remained onsite to install another contingency soil bore. I will leave it up to your judgment of site constraints and initial data collected closer to the former UST location, on the need for the bore to the north.

Thank you for your expedited response to Workplan Amendment. Since we already have a sample being collected to the north of the USTs and we do not have access to the property adjacent to the north of the Site, we cannot plan a contingency boring at that location for this round of field work. If explosive methane levels are detected in the 5 samples collected, we can revisit additional methane sampling at that time. Is this approach satisfactory to you?
