After series of voice mails over the past week plus; make contact with Norm Ozaki. An NOV was issued in July 2009 but Norm references a NFA letter from Susan Hugo dated May 14, 1998; which I subsequently find in file. The NFA appears to have been a "temporary" measure to meet a pending financial transaction, and note it references a closure package to be generated and sent to the RWQCB for closure concurrence, before final closure notification. Ron Silberman, current owner of the site, nor Norm do not have a copy of that document and want to followup on it. I also note that we don't have that document, or RWQCB concurrence. We (collectively) don't know if it was not agreed with, or if it was not generated and sent for concurrence.
