meeting w/ Tom Moffatt, Vorelco, and Sue Wickham & Bart Miller w/ ESTE.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the potential offsite chlorinated problem. The representative from the property owner and the consultant feel that enough evidence exists from mw-5 that the source of the chlorinated problem appears to be coming from upgradient.

They requested me to pursue possible offsite migration from an offsite source. I requested that they provide me with a work plan proposing to determine the zero line of both the chlorinated and the petroleum problem.

They wanted to know if hydropush would suffice to survey groundwater. I told them I would check w/ Eddy So.

A concern was expressed by Tom Moffat that they didn't want to treat the chlorinated problem for fear that they would pull who knows how much upgradient contamination from offsite.

Discussion re: a vapor extraction system to deal with the pollutants if/when the source of the chlorinated problem could be identified.

Vorelco, Tom Moffat said that from past experience it was not feasible to seek/obtain compensation legally from the perpetrator of the pollution (because it was too big of a hassle).
