I would like to request a change to the approved work plan (May 1, 2009) for this site. I had recommended a boring depth of 45'. Reviewing pre-field work and data, I realized that the depth to water is approximately 12' to 23'. I request that Delta's CPT boring depths be changed from 45' to 30'. The reasoning behind this is that all the monitoring wells are set to approximately 25'. Going to 30' could yield a depth discreet water sample and provide vertical delineation results.
